

POLICY ON TRANSITION TO CODES OF CALIBRATION OF MEASURING INSTRUMENTS IN THE SPHERE OF MEASUREMENTS OF RADIOTECHNICAL VALUES

This document defines the policy of the Republican Unitary Enterprise the Belarusian State Centre for Accreditation (hereinafter, BSCA) oriented to introduction of modification No. 2 dated 01.12.2017 into RI SM 7-05-2016 *Work instruction. Classifier of scope of activities in the field of conformity assessment (laboratories)*

1 This policy is developed with the aim to eliminate findings identified during peer evaluation and that refer to specification of codes of activities in the field of calibration in the sphere of measurements of radiotechnical values (code 016).

2 In order to apply codes of sphere of measurements of radiotechnical values successfully, BSCA ensures the following:

2.1 Retraining of technical assessors and attestation of technical assessors in correspondence with the codes specified in modification No. 2 to RI SM 7-05-2016 dated 01.12.2017 before 31.01.2018.

2.2 Immediate notification of all interested parties about introduction of modification No. 2 to RI SM 7-05-2016 for laboratories which conduct calibration of measuring instruments.

2.3 The annex to the accreditation certificate (scope of accreditation) of those calibration laboratories which conduct calibration of measuring instruments will be issued by accreditation body upon applications of calibration laboratories.

2.4 Update of plans surveillance for revised codes will be done throughout 2018.

3 The laboratories which carry out calibration of measuring instruments in the sphere of measurements of radiotechnical values (code of type of measurements 26.51/99.016 (016)) shall:

3.1 submit application for update of their scope of accreditation;

3.2 prepare the draft scope of accreditation in accordance with the modifications No. 2 to RI SM 7-05-2016.

4. All the work on the implementation of the requirements of the present policies shall be completed before 31.03.2020 (including onsite assessment to confirm competence for codes 26.51/99.016.1 and 26.51/99.016.2. Otherwise scope of accreditation of relevant laboratories for these codes will be suspended.
