*This document defines the policy of the State Enterprise "BSCA" (hereinafter – BSCA) on the transition from STB ISO/IEC 17011-2008 (ISO/IEC 17011:2004, IDT) to GOST ISO/IEC 17011-2018 (ISO/IEC 17011:2017, IDT).*

1. New version of ISO/IEC 17011: 2017 «Conformity assessment – Requirements for accreditation bodies accrediting conformity assessment bodies» was published **in November 2017**.

2. In accordance with ILAC/IAF General Assembly Resolution №2 (Vancouver, 2017) Transition Plan to ISO/IEC 17011:2017 dated 29 October 2017 was published. The current Plan sets that:

– all activity on the transition to ISO/IEC 17011:2017 shall be completed **by November 2020**;

– all peer evaluation activities of accreditation bodies (initial, revaluations, expanding accreditation and further evaluations) will be carried out for compliance with the requirements ISO/IEC 17011:2017 **from July 1, 2018**.

3. BSCA has developed activities for the transition to ISO/IEC 17011:2017, including:

- endorsement in the Republic of Belarus of the interstate standard GOST ISO/IEC 17011-2018, which is identical to the international standard ISO/IEC 17011:2017;
- organization of the BSCA personnel training to the requirements of GOST ISO/IEC 17011-2018;
- preparation of proposals and amendments to regulatory legal acts in the field of accreditation;
- updating of the BSCA management system documents and their implementation;
- conducting internal audits of the BSCA management system based on the results of transition to GOST ISO/IEC 17011-2018;
- monitoring the competence and activities of personnel in accordance with the requirements of GOST ISO/IEC 17011-2018;
- passing the peer assessment process by the European Cooperation for Accreditation (EA) in November 2019.
